General Instructions:

1. Student projects will be eligible for a maximum grant of Rs.10, 000/-.
2. The project team can have up to a maximum of four students. A team should send only one proposal in a year.
3. It may be noted that the project proposal should be original, innovative and novel.
4. They should promote application of technology in sports, have utility and applicability for implementation in India. Kindly note that the evaluation of the project is also based on these factors.
5. The Project Guide needs to evaluate the project proposals before submission. In absence of an identified project guide College principal can perform the same role.
6. The project team should not change the topic and should not deviate from the objectives of the sanctioned project proposal.
7. Project proposals received will be reviewed by project evaluation committee of SEA, whose decision about selection of project for funding will be final and binding. Decision will be informed to applicant by email.
8. Once acknowledgement of acceptance is received, the award amount will be transferred to the bank account of student Team leader.
9. The sanctioned projects should be completed and the report along with proof of expenditure should be submitted within 6 months from the date of the disbursement of amount.
10. The student team reserves the right to any intellectual property developed out of the project. Any paper, patent or communication as outcome from the project must mention financial assistance from SEA. SEA reserves the right to publicize / promote the project outcome.
