

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

the International Sports Engineering Association

And

The Sports Engineering Association, India

1. Purpose

The International Sports Engineering Association (ISEA) and the Sports Engineering Association, India (SEA) share a mutual mission to develop research and education in sports engineering. With the object of promoting their cooperation, the ISEA and the SEA, individually also "Party" and collectively the "Parties", enter into the following Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU").

2. Forms of Cooperation

Within such fields as are mutually acceptable for the Parties, the following forms of cooperation, amongst others, may be pursued hereunder:

- Mutual recognition of each Party including the use of the term 'Partner Association' on websites and other promotional materials;
- Commitment to undertake best efforts to cooperate and collaborate on activities such as conferences, events, competitions and special projects;
- Commitment to not pursue any activities that may damage the other Party, or the partnership.

3. Specific Cooperation Projects

Specific cooperation projects, for instance within such fields as described in section 2 above, may be negotiated separately between the Parties and may be established in separate written agreements, stating the respective rights and obligations of the Parties. In case of any ambiguity or conflict of terms between the terms and conditions of this MoU and those of a separate agreement as mentioned above, the terms and conditions of such separate agreement shall prevail.

4. Mutual membership

In order to facilitate effective coordination, each party commits that at least one

individual from each Party shall retain a full membership of the other Party's Association.

5. General Coordinators

Each Party shall designate an individual to oversee and facilitate the implementation of any agreements arising out of this MoU. These individuals are:

6. Liability

Except for loss or damages caused through gross negligence or intent, the Parties shall have no liability to each other hereunder.

7. Legal Relationship

This MoU shall be construed as a statement of purpose to promote a genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration between the Parties. Nothing in this MoU shall create any legal relationship between the Parties.

8. Commencement, Renewal, Termination

This MoU will be effective from the date of the last signature hereto and will remain in force for a time period of five (2) years, with a possibility for renewal at the end of the five-year-period, subject to the Parties' written agreement. Either Party may terminate this MoU by giving six (2) months' notice in writing to the other Party.


